The tournament will include two sessions each day with an afternoon session beginning at 12:00 noon MST followed by an evening session at 6:00 p.m. MST. Wyoming is expected to contend for the Mountain West Conference (MWC) Championship in the 2005 season. Led by 2004 Mountain West Conference Defensive Player of the Year Justin Williams, the Cowboys look to capitalize on their home-court advantage. Last season, Williams led the Conference in blocked shots (2.89 per game) and was third in field-goal percentage (.571).

Charlotte, the favorite to win the Atlantic 10 Conference, will begin their quest toward another post season appearance as the number two seeded team in the tournament. In the past nine years, the 49ers have made seven NCAA Tournament appearances. First Team All-Conference USA and Sports Illustrated All-American Honorable Mention Curtis Withers leads what could be one of the best frontcourts in the nation.
