Princeton, NJ (November 15, 2002) - A national teleconference for the second annual Dell BCA Invitational was held yesterday. The call featured Floyd Keith, Executive Director of the Black Coaches Association, and the four head coaches from the participating teams: Dale Layer (Colorado State), Rollie Massimino (Cleveland State), Sidney Green (Florida Atlantic), and Doug Noll (IPFW).
