Oregon receives bid into CBI tourney

EUGENE — The University of Oregon men's basketball

team accepted an invitation to play in the College Basketball Invitational and will host Weber State on Wednesday. The game starts at 7 p.m. Pacific and will be played at Matthew Knight Arena in Eugene.

The game will be broadcast on HDNet, which is the official broadcast partner of the CBI.

Oregon is the only team in the 16-team tournament from a traditional power conference. Other matchups include James Madison at Davidson; San Jose State at Creighton; Austin Peay at Boise State; Hofstra at Evansville; Duquesne at Montana; Miami (Ohio) at Rhode Island; and St. Bonaventure at Central Florida.

Oregon (16-17) won a pair of games in the Pac-10 tournament last week, losing in the semifinals to the eventual champion, Washington. Joevan Catron leads the Ducks in scoring (15.0 points per game) and rebounding (6.2 per game).

Weber State (18-13) lost in the semifinals of the Big Sky Conference's tournament, falling 57-40 to Montana. The Wildcats feature four players that average double figures in scoring, led by Lindsley Hughey (12.5 points per game).

Oregon State won the CBI in 2009.
