## Michigan falls to Syracuse

Kris Joseph scored 22 points as No. 10 Syracuse defeated Michigan, , tonight in the semifinals of the Legends Classic in Atlantic City, N.J.

The Wolverines (3-1) will play Texas-El Paso at 5:30 p.m. tomorrow.

Freshman Jordan Morgan and Stu Douglass, who came off the bench, each scored 11 points for U-M, which shot 35% (20-for-57) from the field and hit only 8 of 30 three-point shots (27%).

Scoop Jardine scored 11 points and Rick Jackson added 10 points and 10 rebounds for the Orange (5-0). SU shot 42% (20-for-48) from the field and outrebounded U-M, 32-29.

U-M trailed by four with less than two minutes to play when **Tim Hardaway Jr.** came up with a steal. However, he missed a three-pointer. Syracuse got the rebound, but Rick Jackson missed a dunk with a minute remaining, giving U-M another chance. but Darius Morris missed a shot and the Orange came down with the rebound, forcing U-M to foul.

After Joseph split a pair of free throws, Hardaway hit a jumper, bringing the Wolverines to within three. Syracuse's Scoop Jardine was then fouled, and his two free throws essentially iced **the game** away.

The Orange had a four point lead with about 8 minutes to go in the **game** before U-M got a dunk from Tim Hardaway Jr. and a three-pointer from Douglass to take a 45-44 lead with 5:53 remaining. But Scoop Jardine answered with a three of his own to put Syracuse back on top.

Michigan led, 31-29, at halftime, but Syracuse opened the second half with a 9-2 run in three

minutes to take a five-point lead.
