

Bray Reaches 1,000 as Men's Hoops Advances in CBI Tourney

Princeton advanced out of the first round for the third time in as many College Basketball Invitational tournament appearances, but it took the Tigers withstanding a late Tulane rally to win 56-55.

Princeton was ahead by as many as 14 points in the second half and by seven with 31 seconds to go, but the Green Wave, with a winning season on the line, whittled it down to the final margin on a Jonathan Stark 3-pointer with three tenths of a second left.

The game also saw T.J. Bray score his 1,000th career point, making him the 30th Tiger to do so. The milestone bucket came on a breakaway layup less than a minute into the second half.

Princeton overcame being outrebounded by Tulane 35-26 by slightly outshooting the Green Wave 42.9 percent to 40.8 percent on the same number of field goal tries - 49 - as well as benefiting from 16 Tulane turnovers to 11 for the Tigers.
