PUNCH YOUR TICKET: Seventeen of the 34 teams that have competed in the Gotham Classic went on to earn postseason bids that March, with eight of those teams going to the NCAA Tournament. Most recently, Louisville went 4-0 in the Gotham Classic and earned a 2017 NIT berth. In 2015, Pittsburgh reached the NCAA Tournament, Davidson earned an NIT bid, and Eastern Washington, Morehead State, and Western Carolina each garnered CBI bids with Morehead State reaching the Championship Series. In 2014, West Virginia and NC State, who squared off in one of the Showcase Round games, each advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. In 2013, Ohio State, which won the Showcase Game, as well as North Dakota State and Delaware received NCAA tickets. In 2012, Syracuse and Temple both went to the NCAAs with the Orange advancing to the Final Four.

THE MAN: Jack Gibbs of Davidson was a scoring machine during the 2015 Gotham Classic, establishing records for points in a tournament (116) and points in a game (41).

POINTS-A-PLENTY: The 2018 Gotham Classic was indeed a high scoring affair. In the 10 games played teams combined to score an average of 151.2 points in each game. That surpassed the previous high of 150.4 points per game set in 2015. Eight teams scored at least 80 points in a game in 2018, with two of those coming in overtime losses (95, William & Mary vs. UIC; 88, UIC vs. Duquesne). Now in his 23rd year at Notre Dame, head coach Mike Brey is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history while becoming the only Irish head coach to reach 400 victories (481) wins at Notre Dame and 579 in his career...Nate Laszewski paced the Irish in scoring (19.6 ppg) and rebounding (8.8 rpg) while Dane Goodwin, who entered the year with eight 20+ point scoring performances, has two through five games and is the Irish's second leading scorer at 18.4 ppg...JJ Starling (14.0 ppg) and Trey Wertz (13.2 ppg, team-high 20 assists) also score in double figures...Notre Dame is making its third appearance in the Gotham Classic presented by Discount Tire, having previously played in 2013 and 2018.

In 16 years at St. Bonaventure, Mark Schmidt has turned the Bonnies program into a consistent challenger for the Atlantic 10 title...his 271 wins at St. Bonaventure are more than the combined record of the five previous SBU coaches (227)...the Bonnies return only four points from last year after being devastated by the portal...among the new faces are St. Peter's transfer Daryl Banks III who paces SBU with 19.2 ppg...Holy Cross transfer Kyrell Luc nets 16.0 ppg and leads the team with 31 assists...freshman Yann Farrell paces the team with a 6.8 rpg to go with a 10.0 ppg average...this is the Bonnies' first Gotham Classic appearance.

A BRIEF HISTORY

2021- After COVID-19 caused cancellation of the 2020 Gotham Classic, Madison Square Garden opened its doors to the 2021 event which featured St. John's taking on long-time former Big East foe Pitt. The game was close throughout with St. John's Dylan Addae-Wusu tying the game on a pair of free throws with eight seconds left. Jamarius Burton then took the inbounds pass and stormed down the court before lifting the game-winning shot from the left side with four seconds remaining to give the Panthers a 59-57 win.

2019- Saint Louis went 4-0 in the Gotham Classic and defeated Boston College 64-54 in the Showcase Game as 17 Billiken offensive rebounds led to 16 second chance points, resulting in a 16-5 margin in that category. SLU's Jordan Goodwin had game highs of 20 points and 14 rebounds to capture Most Outstanding Player honors.

2018- Notre Dame's defense held Duquesne to just 21-of-60 shooting from the field, including 6-of-27 from three, in capturing a 67-56 win in the Showcase Game of the Gotham Classic. The Fighting Irish also forced 16 Dukes turnovers and blocked 10 shots in posting their third win in four Gotham Classic games. John Mooney led the Irish with 16 points, 10 rebounds, and two blocked shots to win Most Outstanding Player honors.

2017- Quentin Snider scored 19 points on 6-of-10 shooting from the field, including 3-of-4 from three, and handed out five assists to earn MOP honors and lead Louisville to an 81-72 win over Memphis in the Showcase Game of the Gotham Classic. The Cardinals went 4-0 in the tournament and shattered the tourney record for blocked shots as they swatted away 42 shots. Anas Mahmoud accounted for a record 28 of those blocks.

2016- Massachusetts went 4-0, which included a 72-48 win in the Showcase Game against Pacific. Malik Hines was named the Most Outstanding Player, leading a balanced Minutemen squad with eight points, five rebounds, and two blocked shots. Rider tied a tournament record with two road wins, downing Pacific and North Carolina A&T.

2015- Michael Young scored 22 points and hauled down six rebounds as Pitt used a 33-12 run to erase a seven-point first half deficit and beat Davidson 94-69 in the Gotham Classic Showcase Game at Madison Square Garden. Young was named the Most Outstanding Player of the Gotham Classic.

2014- T.J. Cline earned Most Outstanding Player honors for posting team highs of 13 points (5-of-6 shooting from the field), five rebounds, and three assists in leading Richmond to a 65-63 win over Pepperdine at Madison Square Garden. The contest saw 12 lead changes and four ties - mostly in the first half - as the Spiders took the lead for good with 12:03 to play.

In the nightcap, Juwan Staten scored 24 points and handed out six assists to take MOP laurels as No. 22 West Virginia claimed an 83-69 win over NC State. The Wolfpack's Trevor Lacey also netted 24 points.

2013- Lenzelle Smith, Jr. scored seven of his nine points in the final 33 seconds as No. 2 Ohio State rallied from an eight-point deficit with 58 seconds to play to beat Notre Dame, 64-61. The Buckeyes closed the game on a 14-3 run and Smith was the key to the closing spurt. LaQuinton Ross led the Buckeyes with 16 points and 11 rebounds to garner Most Outstanding Player honors.

2012- In the inaugural Gotham Classic, Khalif Wyatt scored a career-high 33 points in leading Temple to an 83-79 victory over No. 3 Syracuse. The win marked the fifth straight season Temple had beaten a top 10 team while being unranked themselves. C.J. Fair had a career-high 25 points for Syracuse, which saw its 52-game regular season non-conference winning streak snapped.
